When did you start dancing with Johnsonville Scottish Country Dance Club?

I moved to Johnsonville in mid-1981, and was very pleased to find that the club met 2 minutes walk from where I was living. This was the last year that Glenys Mills taught the club. Marjorie Crawford taught from 1982 onwards.

How did you get into Scottish country dancing?

I am now a Gentleman of Leisure, having recently retired from many years of working as a computer programmer. I am interested in astronomy, and am a member of the Wellington Astronomical Society, Variable Stars South, and the Occultations Section of the Royal Astronomical Society of New Zealand. I am also interested in writing, particularly Science Fiction and Fantasy.
