

Newtown McDonalds

(Beaumont, February 2018)

4 couple 32 bar jig in a longwise set

Recommended music:

The Jackdaw (recorded by Craigellachie on Take Your Seats CBCD08)

Bars

- 1 – 4 All four women, taking nearer hands, advance and retire.
- 5 – 8 All four women dance right shoulders around partner and back to place.
WHILE
All four men make arches on the sideline – first and second men (and similarly third and fourth men) turn to face each other and make a double arch with outstretched arms.
- 9 – 16 Men repeat bars 1 to 8, dancing right shoulder around partner on bars 13 to 16.
- 17 – 18 First couple cross giving right hand to partner,
19 – 22 First couple cast down behind opposite line to the bottom (second, third and fourth couples move up on bars 21 and 22)
- 23 – 24 First couple cross giving left hand to partner.
- 25 – 32 Third and fourth couples (middle couples) dance four hands across and back



For Elaine Lethbridge and the Newtown Juniors.

Written as a children's dance that all can enjoy.

Note: The outstretched arms of the two dancers making the arch need not touch.
